

Low Vision

Persons living with low vision are impacted physically, emotionally and socially.

Each low vision rehabilitation program is individually prescribed to improve specific living, working, educational, and recreational activities.

Vision is enhanced through the use of optical and non-optical devices, specialized techniques, and training.

Low Vision Rehabilitation

An optometrist will perform a comprehensive evaluation which will help you:

- Understand your vision
- Use your vision more effectively
- Identify the appropriate devices

Based on the individual's goals and the results of the comprehensive evaluation, a personalized rehabilitation plan will be created which will assist in areas such as:

- Reading and writing
- Participating in social activities
- Performing leisure, work, home living and/or school activities
- Driving

Assistive Technology

On site technology using the newest devices such as:

- Video magnifiers
- Bioptic telescopic spectacles
- Optical magnifiers
- Telescopes
- Lighting
- Visual field expanding lenses

Driving Rehabilitation Training program may include:

- Bioptic or hand-held telescope use
- Dynamic visual skills
- Activities of daily living
- Optical and non-optical devices and other adaptive equipment
- Patient and/or family education
